FACTS ABOUT THE FREE AND REDUCED PRICED MEALS PROGRAM

- Cedarburg School District is offering a School Breakfast program for High School students at a cost of paid: \$1.60, reduced: \$0.30. Meals are served before the school day begins at the CHS Dawg Haus. The breakfast must meet the daily minimum requirements for all three food groups at breakfast (milk, fruit, grain/meat/meat alternative).
- Free and Reduced Priced Meals consists of one basic hot lunch which includes one milk. Paid elementary lunch is \$2.75, middle school lunch is \$2.90 and high school lunch is \$3.00. Reduced lunch cost is \$0.40. Students must choose at least three (3) different items from the five (5) food groups that are being offered that day AND each hot lunch must include either a fruit or vegetable. If three (3) food groups including a fruit or vegetable are not chosen, the student may be charged for a full price meal (entrée).
- Milk purchases to accompany a bag lunch brought from home, ala carte items or as a second milk with hot lunch do not qualify as free under the Free and Reduced Price Meals Program. The current price of milk is \$0.40.
- Ala carte items such as pizza, chips, and cookies are not covered under the Free and Reduced Price Meals Program.
- For Grades 6-12: Eligibility for Free or Reduced price meals is coded on your child's Student ID card. The
 Student ID card should be presented to the cashier at the point of payment in the cafeteria. The card will be
 swiped and handed back to the student, no further action is required. Your child's Free or Reduced eligibility
 will remain confidential.
- For Grades K-5: Eligibility for Free or Reduced price meals is coded on your child's Student ID card. ID cards for elementary students are maintained by the classroom teacher. Students who choose to purchase a hot lunch are handed their Student ID card before going to the cafeteria. In the cafeteria, cards are placed in a basket labeled hot lunch. After students go through the hot lunch line a cashier will scan each card in the basket. Your child's Free or Reduced eligibility will remain confidential.
- To purchase ala carte items, milk, or an additional hot lunch or milk, parents/guardians may initiate a Food Service account by sending a check made payable to the Cedarburg School District. Please include your children's first and last names on the check. Payments can be made at your child's school office or by mailing a check to:
